

Maryland Auto Accident Checklist

Steps To Take After A Crash

Immediately After The Accident

- Call 911 and report the accident to police.
- Seek medical attention for injuries, even if symptoms seem minor.
- Move to a safe location if possible.
- Exchange contact and insurance information with other drivers.
- Avoid admitting fault or discussing blame at the scene.

Preserve Evidence

- Take photos and videos of vehicles, injuries, road conditions, and signs.
- Collect names and contact information for witnesses.
- Preserve damaged clothing, receipts, medical records, and repair documents.
- Keep notes about symptoms, treatment, missed work, and accident-related expenses.

Insurance Steps

- Notify your insurance company as required by your policy.
- Be careful when providing recorded statements.
- Do not accept a settlement before understanding the full value of your claim.

Protect Your Rights

- Speak with a Maryland personal injury attorney before making important decisions.
- Learn how Maryland laws, including contributory negligence rules, may affect your claim.
- Keep copies of all accident-related documents.
